

SNx4AC86 Quadruple 2-Input Exclusive-OR Gates

1 Features

- 2V to $6V\ V_{CC}$ operation
- Inputs accept voltages to 6V
- Maximum t_{pd} of 9ns at 5V

2 Description

The 'AC86 devices are quadruple 2-input exclusive-OR gates. The devices perform the Boolean function $Y = A \oplus B$ or $Y = \overline{A}B + A\overline{B}$ in positive logic.


A common application is as a true/complement element. If one of the inputs is low, the other input is reproduced in true form at the output. If one of the inputs is high, the signal on the other input is reproduced inverted at the output.





Figure 3-1. SN54AC86J or W Package; SN74AC86D, DB, N, NS, or PW Package (Top View)

Figure 3-2. SN54AC86 FK Package (Top View)




Figure 3-3. BQA Package (Top View)



6.1 Functional Block Diagram

An exclusive-OR gate has many applications, some of which can be represented better by alternative logic symbols.







Figure 6-1. Exclusive-OR Logic


These five equivalent exclusive-OR symbols are valid for an 'AC86 gate in positive logic; negation may be shown at any two ports.

LOGIC-IDENTITY ELEMENT




The output is active (low) if all inputs stand at the same logic level (i.e., A = B).

EVEN-PARITY ELEMENT



The output is active (low) if an even number of inputs (i.e., 0 or 2) are active. **ODD-PARITY ELEMENT**



The output is active (high) if an odd number of inputs (i.e., only 1 of the 2) are active.

7 Application and Implementation

Note

Information in the following applications sections is not part of the TI component specification, and TI does not warrant its accuracy or completeness. TI's customers are responsible for determining suitability of components for their purposes, as well as validating and testing their design implementation to confirm system functionality.

7.1 Power Supply Recommendations




Figure 7-1. Example Layout for the SN74AC86

The power supply can be any voltage between the minimum and maximum supply voltage rating located in the *Recommended Operating Conditions*. Each V_{CC} terminal should have a bypass capacitor to prevent power disturbance. A $0.1\mu F$ capacitor is recommended for this device. It is acceptable to parallel multiple bypass caps to reject different frequencies of noise. The $0.1\mu F$ and $1\mu F$ capacitors are commonly used in parallel. The bypass capacitor should be installed as close to the power terminal as possible for best results, as shown in Figure 7-1.

7.2 Layout

7.2.1 Layout Guidelines

When using multiple-input and multiple-channel logic devices inputs must not ever be left floating. In many cases, functions or parts of functions of digital logic devices are unused; for example, when only two inputs of a triple-input AND gate are used. Such unused input pins must not be left unconnected because the undefined voltages at the outside connections result in undefined operational states. All unused inputs of digital logic devices must be connected to a logic high or logic low voltage, as defined by the input voltage specifications, to prevent them from floating. The logic level that must be applied to any particular unused input depends on the function of the device. Generally, the inputs are tied to GND or V_{CC} , whichever makes more sense for the logic function or is more convenient.


