



SN54F21 ... J PACKAGE SN74F21 ... D OR N PACKAGE (TOP VIEW)




SN54F21 . . . FK PACKAGE (TOP VIEW)





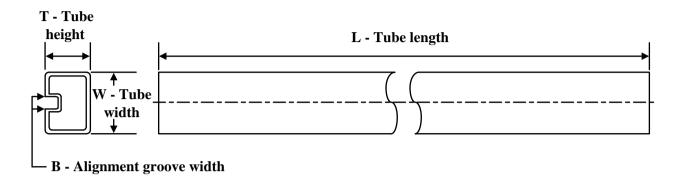
